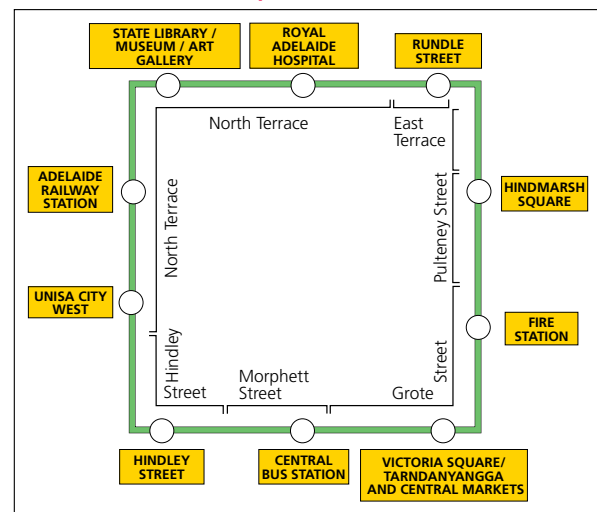

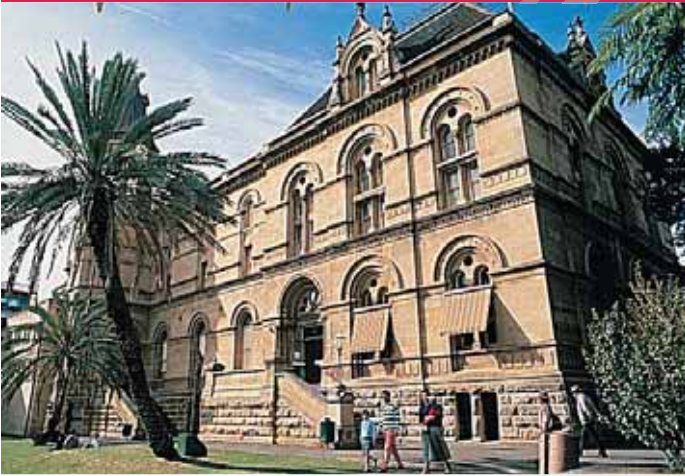

To travel on the FREE Terrace to Terrace tram, board either the Glenelg or South Terrace tram services departing:

Monday to Friday:

8 am - 6 pm: every 7.5 minutes on average

Saturday, Sunday and Public Holidays:

9 am - 6 pm: every 15 minutes approximately

Other times to Midnight:

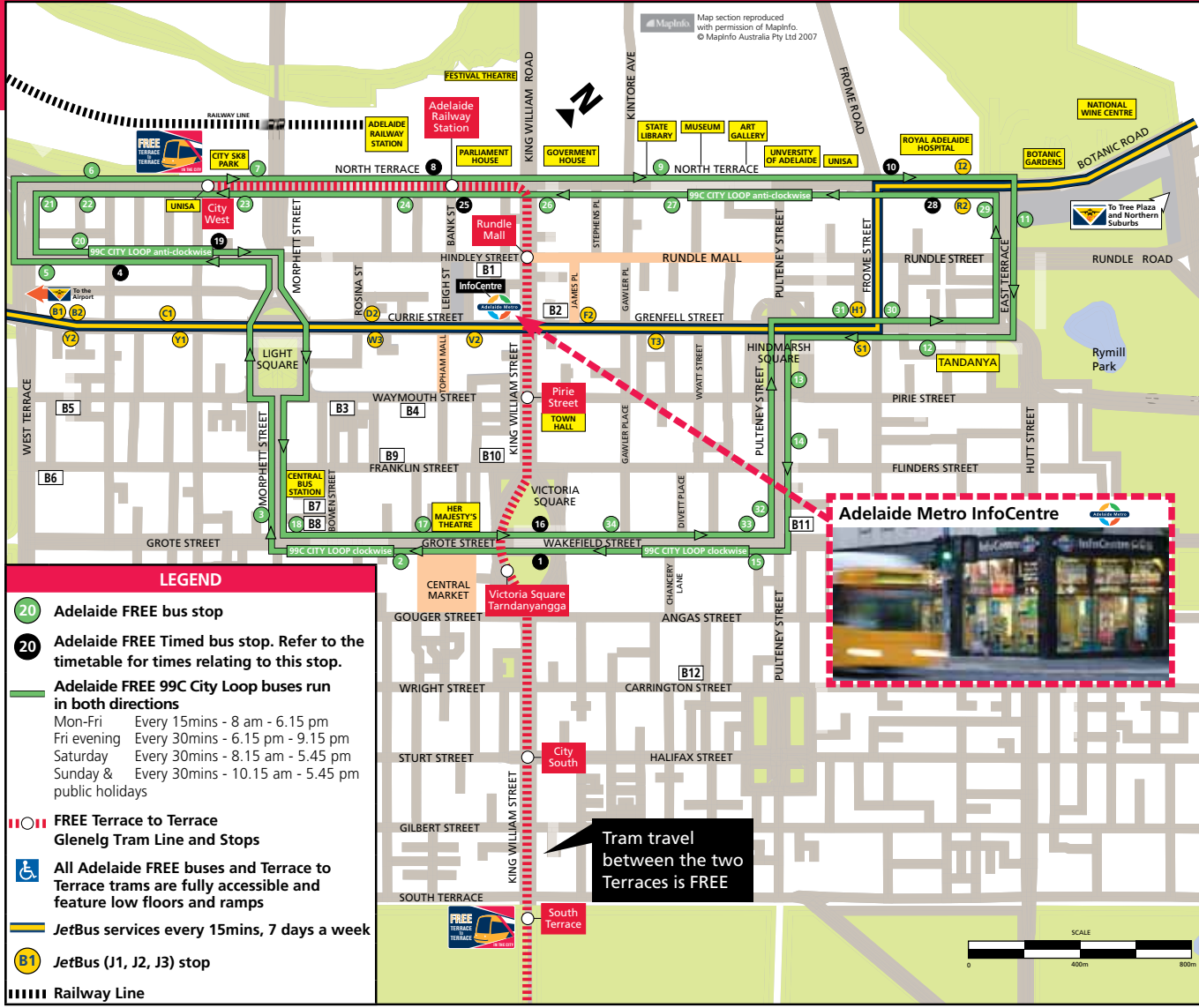
Every 20 minutes approximately

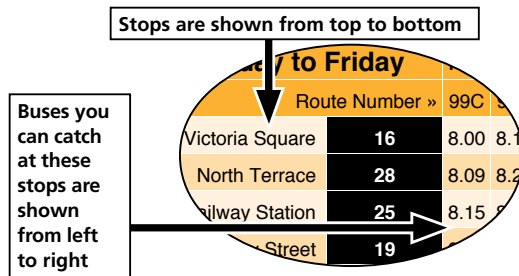

How do I read my timetable to know when my service is coming?



The timetable now reads left to right to allow for natural reading flow.

Each stop shown on these timetables is called a timed stop. As a rule there are approximately 6 stops in between each timed stop shown. If you refer to the route map you can see which stops are ordinary stops and which are timed stops. If your stop is not a timed stop a useful guide is to allow approximately 1 minute for each stop situated between your stop and the previous timed stop.
