## Terms and Conditions – Win a metroCARD competition

1. The promotor of this competition is the South Australian Government through the Department for Infrastructure and Transport ('the Department').
2. The competition will be open from **12:01am 30 October until 11:59:59pm 30 November 2023**.
3. Any person who posts a recent picture on the following social media platforms [Facebook and X (formerly Twitter)] of a moustache decal on an Adelaide Metro vehicle, includes the **#AdelaideMetMo** hashtag and tags Adelaide Metro (@DFITSA on Facebook and @DFITSA on X) automatically registers for the competition and will be put into the draw to win a Regular metroCARD with \$50 value loaded onto it (**Prize**). Only one entry per person will be admitted into the draw.
4. Entrants must take all reasonable care for their own safety and the safety of others and comply with all road rules and other applicable laws in taking a picture or pictures of Adelaide Metro services for the purpose of entering this competition.
5. The Prize is valued at \$55 inclusive of the metroCARD fee.
6. The Prize is not transferable and cannot be redeemed for cash.
7. Entry to this Prize draw is free but is limited to one entry per person.
8. Entry is open to South Australian residents only.
9. Under conditions of the SA Public Sector Code of Ethics, Department employees and other SA Government employees can enter the competition, but SA Government employees and their immediate families are ineligible to win the Prize.
10. The Prize draw will take place at 83 Pirie Street, Adelaide 1 December 2023. The winner will be notified by instant message via the social media platform used to enter the competition. Notification to the winner will include instructions on how to claim the Prize. The Department may require the winner to provide proof of identity when claiming the Prize.
11. The Prize must be claimed within 30 days from the date of notification by the Department (**Prize Claim Period**). If not collected in the Prize Claim Period the Prize will be deemed to be forfeited.
12. The winner's name may be published via the Department's social media accounts. Entry into competition and acceptance of the Prize by the winner will be deemed as consent for such publication unless the winner objects in writing to publication of their name at or prior to claiming the Prize.
13. The Department's decision regarding a winner is final and it will not enter into correspondence regarding the prize draw or winning entries. The Department may conduct a redraw of the Prize where the winning entry is disqualified under these terms and conditions or the winner fails to claim or collect the prize in the Prize Claim Period.
14. The Department accepts no responsibility for any tax implications that may arise from the Prize being awarded to the winner.
15. The Department shall not be liable for any loss (including, without limitation, indirect or consequential loss), damage, personal injury or death which is suffered or sustained (including but not limited to that arising from any person's negligence) in connection with this competition, except any liability that cannot be excluded by law (in which case that liability is limited to the maximum extent permitted by law)
16. The Department reserves the right to verify the validity of entries and reserves the right to disqualify any competition participant for tampering with the entry process or for submitting an entry which is not in accordance with these Terms and Conditions, or if the competition participant is engaged in any unlawful or other improper misconduct calculated to jeopardise the fair and proper conduct of the competition. The Department's legal rights to recover damages or other compensation from such an offender are reserved.
17. The Department reserves the right to cancel, terminate, modify or suspend the competition at any time.
18. Entry into the competition is deemed acceptance by the competition participant of these terms and conditions.
19. Entrants hereby grant the Department a non-exclusive, perpetual, irrevocable, assignable, worldwide, transferable, royalty-free, licence to reproduce, modify, distribute, publicly

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display, broadcast, publish, and use competition entries for promoting the competition or the Department's support for the 'Movember' initiative.

20. The personal information submitted in an entry is collected by the Department and will be used by the Department for the purpose of conducting the competition. Personal information supplied by entrants will be handled by the Department in accordance with the Information Privacy Principles contained in the Cabinet Instruction PC012 applicable to SA public sector agencies.
