\* South Australian Seniors Card holders travel free on all Adelaide Metro public transport services at the following times: Monday to Friday midnight to 7.00am, 9.01am to 3.00pm, 7.01pm to midnight, all day Saturday, Sunday and public holidays. At all other times a concession fare is required.

New Regular metroCARD \$5.00 (plus minimum of \$5.00 recharge required).  
New Concession and Student metroCARD \$3.50 (plus minimum of \$5.00 recharge required).

## ⚠ IMPORTANT REMINDERS

- Always validate your Metrocard or ticket when boarding. Fines apply for failing to do so.
- Concession, student and seniors must carry an approved concession or student ID card. If you travel without your ID card you must purchase a regular fare ticket.
- Passengers who do not validate a correct ticket risk prosecution with a maximum penalty of \$1,250.
- Bikes can be carried free on trains Monday to Friday between 9.01am and 3pm or between 6pm and the last service and on Saturday, Sunday and public holidays when space is available. A peak concession fare ticket must be purchased for bikes at all other times.

## Children travelling with adults

Accompanied children under five years old travel free at all times.  
On weekends, school holidays and South Australian public holidays, two children under 15 years of age travel free when accompanied by an adult using a Daytrip Metroticket.
